When nominating, the nominator must outline how the nominee has gone above and beyond at their local football club, league or region.

The nominator must select an award category outlined in the nomination form, being as follows.

Selection Process and Prize Winners

Within each of the 17 WA Football districts and regions, one nominee from each WA Football district and region, will be selected as the district/region winner in the Volunteer of the Year category and announced in The Sunday Times and through the WA Football.

The overall winner of the WA Football Volunteer of the Year award will be announced at WA Football event. If the 2025 event is cancelled due to unforeseen

circumstances the winner will be announced via WA Football digital platforms on the date the event was scheduled to be hosted.

One winner was selected from each subsequent category and will be announced through the WA Football Commission and will be invited to attend the WA Football event.

The overall winner in each category, including WA Football Volunteer of the Year will be submitted as the West Australian nomination in the 2025 Toyota AFL National Volunteer of the Year Awards.

Prizes

In this Program, commencing at 9:00am (WST) on Monday 19 May 2025 and concluding at 11:59pm (WST) on Monday 7 July 2025, the finalists will be announced on Friday 1 August 2025 on the WA Football website and contacted by phone or email.

The WA Football Volunteer of the Year winner will receive a prize to the value of \$4,250. The prize is determined bythe Promoter.
